We value diverse musical backgrounds

We value the inherent musicality of every individual regardless of your past musical education or experiences. Music is a lifelong journey that is augmented and deepened by way of social connection and exposure to a variety of perspectives. We agree that none of us "knows it all" and we respect that each person has a unique background of musical training and experiences that adds value to the group. We will not make assumptions of anything people "should" know at any level, and agree that we can all learn many things of value from each other. Any feedback, whether between classmates or from teachers, is offered with good intent and without judgment.

Connection and privacy

Our supportive community is built on trust. Feedback, milestone posts and live sessions are shared in the library and community as a learning tool. *Under no circumstances will any posts or recordings be shared outside of this program and community.*

No private messages without permission

You must have explicit permission to private message or contact someone in this group. Do not contact any member outside of the community or on any other platform without their requesting you to do so. Do not share your own personal contact information without being invited to do so.

No promotional posts or link-sharing, other than musical performances

Build community and network, we want you to share your ideas and experiences! But when links enter the space it adds challenges for us to provide insight on whether or not we endorse what is being presented. Sharing of links in the community is restricted only to performances that are relevant to you and your training. If sharing a performance link, please include the context/explanation of how that link performance is relevant to your training and the community.

If you would like to recommend a specific book, topic, idea or training method you can do so in discussion by suggesting your fellow classmates search it online themselves without sharing the specific link. You must have explicit invitation and permission to private message or contact someone in this group.
